To whom it may concern,

I personally apologize for the incidents in classroom 121 while substituting the music class of Mr. Paul Kollas. Due to my actions, there were chronic disruptions, loud sound to the point where students were crying, ears hurting including mine, and general disarray throughout the classroom. I take sole responsibility for this, because I enabled the behavior of the students, which otherwise would not have occurred.

Things I tried were hand clapping, raise your hand if you're behaving, and merit based sitting arrangements. While these worked momentarily, they failed immidiately after the desired result was achieved. I learned that I need to be strict from the onset, establishing clear expectations before anything else.

Going forward, I would like to view this experience as an investment in my education. As Thomas J. Watson Sr. (the founder of IBM) said to an employee who lost a significant sum, "I just spent \$600,000 training him", the employee went on to achieve better.
